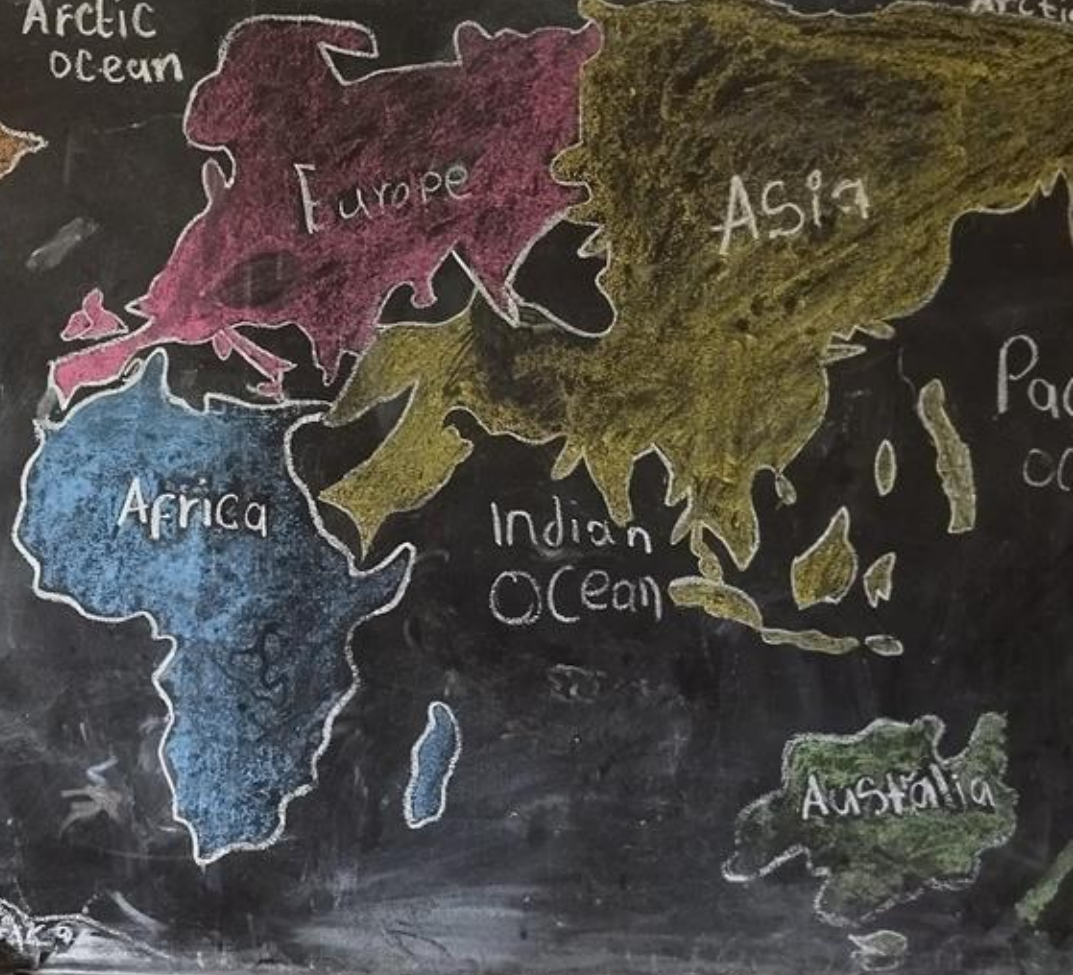

HOW TO LISTEN

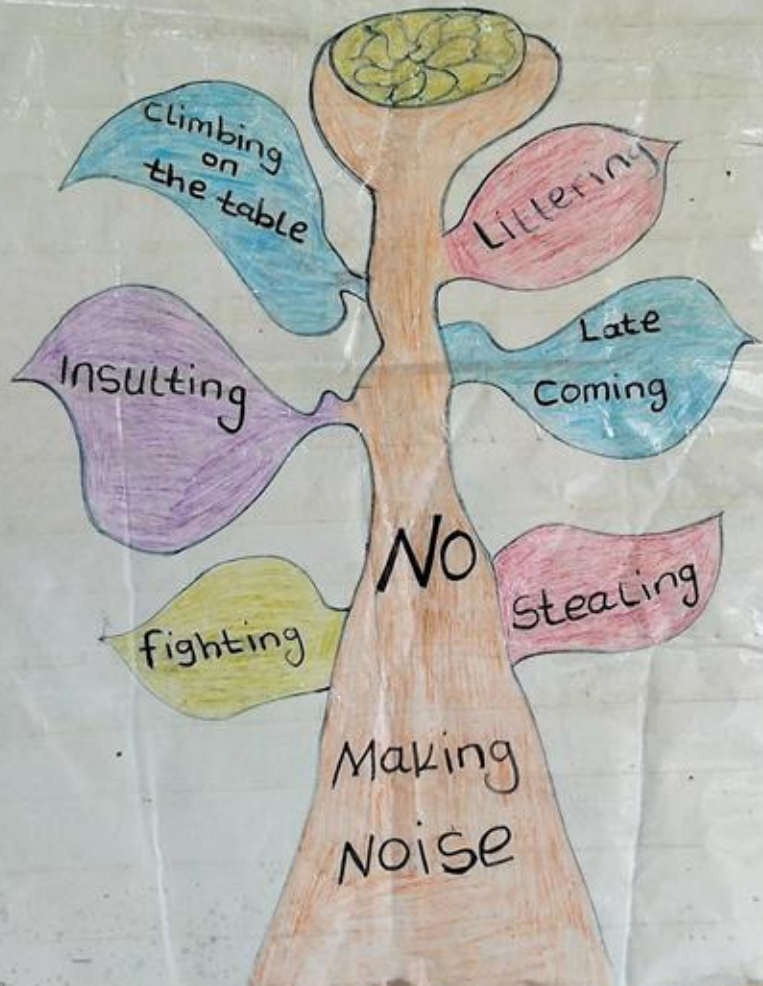
- 1 Concentrate on the speaker and on what is being said.
